Honoring Dr. King Through Service

Each year, The Arc of South Carolina celebrates MLK Day as a day on, not a day off, bringing together community members, students, and volunteers to serve others. Our PB&J Service Project began as a fun, hands-on way to honor Dr. King's legacy — making peanut butter and jelly sandwiches for people experiencing food insecurity throughout the Midlands. The event celebrates teamwork, compassion, and inclusion, showing that everyone can make a difference.

In 2025, volunteers created more than 2,200 sandwiches that were distributed to local organizations including Transitions Homeless Shelter, the SC 153 Project, Oliver Gospel Mission, and Christ Central Columbia. Each sandwich represents a small act of love that adds up to a big community impact.

Who We Serve

The Arc of South Carolina supports individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their families across the state.

Our programs, training, and advocacy efforts help people with IDD of all ages — from early childhood through adulthood — access education, employment, community living, and full participation in society.
